## Debutantes of 1969 Present Check To AV Hospital for Defibrillator

A check for \$594.20 to help finance a new heart defibrillator for the Antelope Valley Hospital was donated to the hospital this week by the Alpha Charter Guild Debutantes of 1969.

The money represented proceeds from the debutante fashion show, "Fashion Pot-pourri," presented by the debutantes on Tues., Aug. 12, at the Antelope Valley Country Club.

Debutantes who officially presented the gift were Judy Bufkin and Shelly Chouteau, both models in the fashion show.

Also taking part in the presentation were Mrs. Albert W. Powell, Hourglass Ball chairman, and Mrs. De Beeler, debutante chairman. Mrs. Raymond Schaper, guild advisor for "Fashion Pot-pourri," was unable to attend the presentation.

Robert E. Ernst, AV Hospital administrator, and Robert Crowder, assistant administrator, accepted the debutante gift on behalf of the hospital.

In donating money for purchase of a defibrillator, the debutantes have joined efforts with adult members of the Alpha Charter Guild

who also are dedicated to helping heart patients of Antelope Valley Hospital. Since 1966, the guild has donated almost \$10,000 for purchase of coronary care heart monitors.

A defibrillator is a machine for the purpose of re-establishing normal heart rhythm by means of an electric current. The new defibrillator will be kept in the AV Hospital Emergency Room, immediately available for live-saving measures. It also may be transported to other nursing areas within the hospital for emergency use.
